

Roof Mount Automatic Satellite Dish \$175 OBO

Winegard AS-2003/RM-8000 18x21 Automatic Rooftop Satellite Dish removed from my trailer to mount a Trav'ler HD dish. I list two model numbers because I'm not sure which one is correct. I have two manuals, one for each number, and I can't tell the difference between them.

According to the manuals this dish will work with Dish Network and DirecTV. The original owners of the trailer used it on Dish. I used it on DirecTV, so I can't speak with any certainty as to how it might work on Dish. I used it for DirecTV standard definition. It will not get HD on DirecTV but I think it will on Dish. It occasionally requires manual intervention when searching, but by watching the signal strength indicators and stopping the search when it sees a signal it works fine. I usually let it search and if it can't find the satellite by itself I help it the second time. That process has always worked. One benefit is that it requires only 12 volts to operate, so it can be used when shore power is not available.

It was originally improperly installed on my trailer, so I had to extend the cables to ensure they cleared the feed arm when searching. Follow the instructions when installing it. I have the original manuals including the installation template, as well as a pdf version. I will also provide a written description of how to use the unit with DirecTV with the current H24 receiver as the original manual does not cover DirecTV very well.

I will have the unit available at the Region 3 Rally in Hiawassee for inspection.
